SALES/TOBACCO DEALERS: Provides relative to vapor products

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 26:901(10), (22), and (26)(introductory paragraph), relative to
3	tobacco products; to provide relative to certain vapor products; to provide relative
4	to manufacturers of tobacco products; to provide relative to stamping agents; to
5	provide relative to excise or tobacco taxes; to provide for definitions; and to provide
6	for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 26:901(10), (22), and (26)(introductory paragraph) are hereby
9	amended and reenacted to read as follows:
10	§901. Definitions
11	As used in this Chapter, the following terms have the meaning ascribed to
12	them in this Section, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
13	* * *
14	(10) "Manufacturer" means anyone engaged in the manufacture, production,
15	or foreign importation of tobacco products, vapor products, or alternative nicotine
16	products who sells to wholesalers. A manufacturer shall specifically include a
17	person that mixes, compounds, repackages, or resizes vapor products.

19	(22) "Stamping agent" means a dealer that is authorized to affix tax stamps
20	to any packages or other containers of cigarettes under R.S. 47:843 et seq. or any

1 dealer that is required to pay the excise tax or tobacco tax imposed pursuant to R.S. 2 47:841 et seq. on cigarettes. 3 4 (26) "Vapor product" means any non-combustible product containing nicotine or other substances that employs a heating element, power source, electronic 5 6 circuit, or other electronic, chemical or mechanical means, regardless of shape or 7 size, that can be used to produce vapor from nicotine in a solution or other form and 8 is manufactured, distributed, marketed, or sold as any type of derivation of a vapor 9 product. "Vapor product" includes any electronic cigarette, electronic cigar, electronic cigarillo, electronic pipe, or similar product or device and any vapor 10 11 cartridge or other container of nicotine in a solution or other form that is intended to 12 be used with or in an electronic cigarette, electronic cigar, electronic cigarillo, electronic pipe, or similar product or device. "Vapor product" does not include any 13 14 of the following: 15 (a) Product that is a drug pursuant to 21 U.S.C. §321(g)(1). 16 (b) Device pursuant to 21 U.S.C. §321(h). 17 (c) Combination product described in 21 U.S.C. §353(g). 18
