SCHOOLS/NONPUBLIC: Requires BESE to develop and implement a school accountability system for approved nonpublic schools

AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 17:10.9, relative to school accountability; to require the State Board of 3 Elementary and Secondary Education to develop and implement an accountability 4 system for certain nonpublic schools; to provide relative to criteria; to provide for 5 effectiveness; and to provide for related matters. 6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 7 Section 1. R.S. 17:10.9 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 8 §10.9. School accountability system; nonpublic schools 9 A. The State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education shall develop 10 and implement a school accountability system for nonpublic schools that are 11 approved by the board and that receive public funds. 12 B. The system, to the extent possible, shall be comparable to and contain the 13 same components, requirements, and criteria as the school and district accountability 14 system for public schools, including but not limited to requirements for student 15 testing, assignment of letter grades to schools, and reporting of results to parents. 16 Section 2. The State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education shall implement 17 a school accountability system for certain nonpublic schools as provided in this Act effective 18 for the 2012-2013 school year and thereafter.

Burrell HB No. 351

Abstract: Requires BESE to develop and implement an accountability system for certain nonpublic schools.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds that the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) shall develop, and, beginning with the 2012-2013 school year, implement a school accountability system for all nonpublic schools that are BESE-approved and that receive public funds. Such system, to the extent possible, shall be comparable to and contain the same components, requirements, and criteria as the accountability system for public schools, including but not limited to requirements for student testing, assignment of letter grades to schools, and reporting of results to parents.
