6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:		
7	Section 1. R.S. 30:2054(B)(11) is hereby enacted to read as follows:		
8	§2054. Air quality control; secretary of environmental quality; powers and duties

10	B. The secretary shall have the following powers and duties:

12	(11) To adopt and promulgate rules and regulations requiring service stations		
13	dispensing or selling motor vehicle fuel in this state to equip fuel dispensing devices		
14	with a certified vapor recovery system, commonly known as a type II vapor recovery		
15	system. Such rules and regulations shall provide for the classifications of service		
16	stations, applications, training of personnel, testing, labeling, and recordkeeping.

Abstract: Requires vapor recovery systems on motor fuel dispensing equipment.

<u>Present law</u> requires the secretary of the Dept. of Environmental Quality to control the air resources of the state.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary to adopt and promulgate rules and regulations requiring service stations dispensing or selling motor vehicle fuel in this state to equip fuel pumps with a certified vapor recovery system, commonly known as a type II vapor recovery system.

<u>Proposed law</u> further requires such rules and regulations to provide for the classifications of service stations, applications, training of personnel, testing, labeling, and recordkeeping.
