AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 14:91.2(A)(2) and (3) and (B)(1) and (2), relative to the unlawful presence of sex offenders; to amend provisions relative to the unlawful presence of certain offenders convicted of a sex offense; to provide relative to child care facilities; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 14:91.2(A)(2) and (3) and (B)(1) and (2) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§91.2. Unlawful presence of a sex offender

A. The following acts when committed by a person convicted of a sex offense as defined in R.S. 15:541 when the victim is under the age of thirteen years shall constitute the crime of unlawful residence or presence of a sex offender:

(2) The offender establishing a residence within one thousand feet of any public or private elementary or secondary school or child care facility as defined in R.S. 46:1403.

(3) The physical presence of the offender in, on, or within one thousand feet of a public park, ~~or recreational facility,~~ or child care facility as defined in R.S. 46:1403.
