2	To amend and reenact R.S. 11:710(D) and to enact R.S. 11:710(A)(4), relative to the
3	Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana; to allow certain reemployed retirees to
4	receive benefits during reemployment; to provide an effective date; and to provide
5	for related matters.
6	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
7	as provided by Article X, Section 29(C) of the Constitution
8	of Louisiana.
9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 11:710(D) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 11:710(A)(4)
11	is hereby enacted to read as follows:
12	§710. Employment of retirees
13	A. For purposes of this Section, "retired teacher" shall mean any of the
14	following:
15	* * *
16	(4) A retired member who has a valid Louisiana teaching certificate who
17	returns to active service covered by the provisions of this Chapter who is assigned
18	the professional activities of instructing adults through an adult education or literacy
19	program administered through a public institution of elementary or secondary
20	education. Such individual's earnings from his return to active service shall not
21	exceed twenty-five percent of his benefit during any fiscal year. If actual earnings
22	exceed this amount in any fiscal year, the benefits payable to the retiree shall be
23	reduced by the amount in excess of twenty-five percent of his benefit.

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D. When any retiree returns to active service with an employer covered by the provisions of this Chapter, the employing agency shall, within thirty days thereafter, notify the board of trustees in writing of such employment, the date on which employment commenced, and a determination by the employer as to whether such person is a "retired teacher" pursuant to Subsection A of this Section. Upon termination, the agency shall provide the same notice. In addition, the employing agency shall also report to the retirement system within forty-five days after June thirtieth of each year, the name of all persons being paid by the employing agency, their social security numbers, their designation as parttime or fulltime, and the amount of their earnings during the previous fiscal year ending on June thirtieth of the reporting year. Should failure to give notice of return to active service result in any payment being made in violation of this Section, the employing agency shall be liable to the system for the repayment of such amounts.

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Section 2. The cost of this Act, if any, shall be funded with additional employer contributions in compliance with Article X, Section 29(F) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

Section 3. This Act shall become effective if and when the Act which originated as Senate Bill No. 6 of the 2011 Regular Session of Legislature becomes effective.
