#### HOUSE BILL NO. 37

#### BY REPRESENTATIVE BROWN

AN ACT
To amend and reenact R.S. 32:402.1(D) and to enact R.S. 32:410(D), 412(D)(3)(f) and
(4)(d), and R.S. 40:1321(N), relative to driver's licenses and special identification
cards; to provide for participation in driver training programs; to provide the option
for a driver to place their blood type on the front of their license; to provide for
driver's license renewal for individuals with a disability; and to provide for related
matters.
Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
Section 1. R.S. 32:402.1(D) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 32:410(D)
and $412(D)(3)(f)$ and $(4)(d)$ are hereby enacted to read as follows:
§402.1. Driver education; required
* * *
D. No person under the age of fifteen shall be allowed to enroll or participate
in the driving experience portion of any driver education course or driver training
program. A person, no sooner than ninety days prior to his fifteenth birthday and
who is in, at a minimum, grade nine eight, shall be permitted to participate in the
classroom instruction component of a driver education course or driving program.

§410. Form of license; photograph, signature of licensee, anatomical gift statement,
declaration of life-sustaining procedures, and additional information on
license

D.(1) Upon request, the license holder's blood type shall be exhibited on the
back of the driver's license regardless of its class. No additional fee shall be charged
