17	one of the following requirements:
18	(a) Increase the wages of those persons who successfully complete the

Abstract: Provides with respect to the Incumbent Worker Training Program.

<u>Present law</u> creates the Incumbent Worker Training Program and establishes a fund for the administration of the program.

<u>Present law</u> provides conditions which a training provider must meet in order to receive monies from the fund for training services.

Present law provides that the provider shall agree to one of the following requirements:

- (1) Increase the wages for the persons who complete the training.
- (2) Create new jobs.
- (3) Give preference to the currently unemployed when hiring.
- (4) Provide an in-kind-match.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for an in-kind match for services as a program requirement, and otherwise retains present law.
