A rule adopted in accordance with R.S. 49:953 shall expire on June 9 thirtieth of the year following the year of its adoption unless legislation is enacted 10 to continue the effectiveness of the rule to a certain date or indefinitely.

Abstract: Provides for expiration of agency rules.

<u>Present law</u> provides that each rule adopted shall be effective upon its publication in the La. Register.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and provides that a rule adopted in accordance with nonemergency procedures shall expire on June 30th of the year following the year of its adoption unless legislation is enacted to continue such rule to a certain date or indefinitely.
