PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS: Authorizes the governing authority of the town of Farmerville to name the Farmerville Recreation Center in honor of Willie Davis, Jr.

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 33:4712.14, relative to naming a recreation center; to authorize the governing
3 authority of the town of Farmerville to name the Farmerville Recreation Center in
4 honor of Willie Davis, Jr.; and to provide for related matters.

5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
6 as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
7 Louisiana.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 33:4712.14 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

10 §4712.14. Naming of Farmerville Recreation Center

11 The governing authority of the town of Farmerville may name the
12 Farmerville Recreation Center in honor of Willie Davis, Jr.

Abstract: Authorizes the governing authority of the town of Farmerville to name the Farmerville Recreation Center in honor of Willie Davis, Jr.

Present law provides that no public building, public bridge, public park, public fish or game preserve, or public wildlife refuge owned by the state or by any political subdivision of the

state or by any institution receiving its support in whole or in part from the state shall be named in honor of any living person, except as authorized or provided by law.

Proposed law retains present law and authorizes the governing authority of the town of Farmerville to name the Farmerville Recreation Center in honor of Willie Davis, Jr.
