APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT: Appropriates funds for payment of judgment against the state in the matter of "Fredia Cross v. Universal Casualty Insurance Company, et al"

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2011-  
3 2012 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Fredia Cross v.  
4 Universal Casualty Insurance Company, Lafayette City Parish Consolidated  
5 Government, the State of Louisiana, through the Department of Transportation and  
6 Development; Sarah Spell Johnson and Louis Adams"; and to provide for related  
7 matters.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. The sum of Four Hundred Fifty-Two and 02/100 (\$452.02) Dollars is  
10 hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2011-  
11 2012 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Fredia Cross v. Universal  
12 Casualty Insurance Company, Lafayette City Parish Consolidated Government, the State of  
13 Louisiana, through the Department of Transportation and Development; Sarah Spell Johnson  
14 and Louis Adams", bearing Number 2006-4865-I on the docket of the 15th Judicial District  
15 Court, parish of Lafayette, state of Louisiana.

16 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2011; if vetoed by the governor  
17 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,  
18 2011, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
