1	A JOINT RESOLUTION
2	Proposing to amend Article VII, Section $18(G)(1)(a)(iv)$ of the Constitution of Louisiana,
3	relative to the special assessment level for ad valorem property taxes; to exclude the
4	requirement of annual certification of adjusted gross income for certain eligible
5	owners; to provide for submission of the proposed amendment to the electors; and
6	to provide for related matters.
7	Section 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of the members
8	elected to each house concurring, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state of
9	Louisiana, for their approval or rejection in the manner provided by law, a proposal to
10	amend Article VII, Section 18(G)(1)(a)(iv) of the Constitution of Louisiana, to read as
11	follows:
12	§18. Ad Valorem Taxes
13	* * *
14	(G) Special Assessment Level.
15	(1)(a)
16	* * *
17	(iv) An owner who is below the age of sixty-five and who has applied for
18	and received the special assessment level may qualify for and receive the special
19	assessment level in the subsequent year by certifying to the assessor of the parish,
20	or in the parish of Orleans, the assessor of the district where the property is located,
21	that such person or persons' adjusted gross income in the prior tax year satisfied the
22	income requirement of this Section. The provisions of this Subsubparagraph (a)(iv)

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1	Item shall not apply to an owner who has qualified for and received the special
2	assessment level for persons sixty-five years of age or older or to such owner's
3	surviving spouse as described in Subsubparagraph (a)(i) of this Subparagraph Item
4	(2)(a)(i) of this Paragraph or for an owner who is permanently totally disabled as
5	provided for in Subitem (i)(dd) of this Subsubparagraph.

7	Section 2. Be it further resolved that this proposed amendment shall be submitted
8	to the electors of the state of Louisiana at the statewide election to be held on November 8,
9	2022.
10	Section 3. Be it further resolved that on the official ballot to be used at the election,
11	there shall be printed a proposition, upon which the electors of the state shall be permitted
12	to vote YES or NO, to amend the Constitution of Louisiana, which proposition shall read as
13	follows:
14	Do you support an amendment to remove the requirement that homeowners
15	who are permanently totally disabled must annually re-certify their income
16	to keep their special assessment level on their residences for property tax
17	purposes? (Amends Article VII, Section 18(G)(1)(a)(iv))
