Seizure by creditor; special claims 6 7 Notwithstanding any stipulation in the trust instrument to the contrary, the 8 proper court, in summary proceedings to which the trustee, the beneficiary, and the 9 beneficiary's creditor shall be parties, may permit seizure of any portion of the 10 beneficiary's interest in trust income and principal in its discretion and as may be just 11 under the circumstances if the claim is based upon a judgment for: * 12 * 13 (3) Damages arising from a felony criminal offense committed by the 14 beneficiary which results in a conviction or a plea of guilty.
