The only responsive verdicts which may be rendered when the indictment 10 charges the following offenses are: 11 * 12 26. Theft: 13 Guilty of theft of property having a value of one thousand five hundred 14 dollars or more. 15 Guilty of theft of property having a value of five hundred dollars or more, but 16 less than one thousand five hundred dollars. 17 Guilty of theft of property having a value of three hundred dollars or more, 18 but less than five hundred dollars. 19 Guilty of theft of property having a value of less than three five hundred 20 dollars. 21 Guilty of attempted theft of property having a value of one thousand five 22 hundred dollars or more. 23 Guilty of attempted theft of property having a value of three five hundred 24 dollars or more, but less than one thousand five hundred dollars.
