2	To amend and reenact R.S. 14:102.2(C), relative to offenses affecting public sensibility; to
3	provide with respect to the seizure of animals treated cruelly; and to provide for
4	related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 14:102.2(C) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§102.2. Seizure and disposition of animals cruelly treated
8	* * *
9	C.(1) A person claiming an interest in any animal seized pursuant to this
10	Section may prevent the disposition of the animal as provided for in Subsection B
11	of this Section by posting a bond with the court within fifteen days after receiving
12	notice of such seizure. Such bond shall prevent the disposition of the animal for a
13	period of thirty days in an amount sufficient to secure payment for all reasonable
14	costs incurred in the boarding and treatment for any seized animal for a thirty-day
15	period commencing on the date of initial seizure.
16	(2)(a) The amount of the bond shall be determined by the department,
17	agency, humane society, and the custodian of the animal as authorized by the court
18	and shall be sufficient to secure payment for all reasonable costs incurred during the
19	thirty-day period for the boarding and medical treatment of the animal after
20	examination by a licensed veterinarian.
21	(b) The court shall order that the bond be given to the custodian of the
22	animal to cover such costs.
23	(3) Such bond shall not prevent the department, agency, humane society, or
24	other custodian of the animal from disposing of the animal in accordance with

1	Subsection B of this Section at the end of the thirty-day period covered by the bond,
2	unless the person claiming an interest posts an additional bond for such reasonable
3	expenses for an additional thirty-day period. In addition, such bond shall not prevent
4	disposition of the animal for humane purposes at any time, in accordance with
5	Subsection E of this Section. The amount of the bond shall be determined by the
6	department, agency, humane society or other custodian of the animal as authorized
7	by the court in accordance with the current rate for board and on the condition of the
8	animal after examination by a licensed veterinarian.
