2	To amend and reenact R.S. 39:54(B), relative to nonrecurring revenue; to provide for
3	allowable uses of nonrecurring revenue; to provide for the payment of unfunded
4	accrued liabilities; to provide for effectiveness; and to provide for related matters.
5	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
6	as provided by Article X, Section 29(C) of the Constitution
7	of Louisiana.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 39:54(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
10	§54. Limitations on appropriations
11	* * *
12	B. Appropriation of any money designated in the official forecast as
13	nonrecurring shall be made only in accordance with the following:
14	(1) At a minimum, twenty-five percent of nonrecurring revenue shall be
15	appropriated for deposit in the Budget Stabilization Fund.
16	(2)(a) Providing for payments against the unfunded accrued liability of the
17	public retirement systems which are in addition to any payments required for the
18	annual amortization of the unfunded accrued liability of the public retirement
19	systems, required by Article X, Section 29(E)(2)(c) of the Constitution of Louisiana;
20	however, any such payment to the public retirement systems shall not be used,
21	directly or indirectly, to fund cost-of-living increases for such systems.
22	(b) At a minimum, for Fiscal Years 2013-2014 and 2014-2015, the
23	legislature shall appropriate no less than five percent of any money designated in the
24	official forecast as nonrecurring to the Louisiana State Employees' Retirement

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1	System and the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana for application to the
2	balance of the unfunded accrued liability of such systems existing as of June 30,
3	1988, in proportion to the balance of such unfunded accrued liability of each such
4	system. Any such payments to the public retirement systems shall not be used,
5	directly or indirectly, to fund cost-of-living increases for such systems.
6	(c) At a minimum, for Fiscal Year 2015-2016 and every fiscal year
7	thereafter, the legislature shall appropriate no less than ten percent of any money
8	designated in the official forecast as nonrecurring to the Louisiana State Employees'
9	Retirement System and the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana for application
10	to the balance of the unfunded accrued liability of such systems existing as of June
11	30, 1988, in proportion to the balance of such unfunded accrued liability of each such
12	system. Any such payments to the public retirement systems shall not be used,
13	directly or indirectly, to fund cost-of-living increases for such systems.
14	(2) (3) After satisfying the requirements of Paragraph Paragraphs (1) and (2)
15	of this Subsection, the remainder may be appropriated only for the following
16	purposes:
17	(a) Retiring or defeasance of bonds in advance and in addition to the existing
18	amortization requirements of the state.
19	(b) Providing for payments against the unfunded accrued liability of the
20	public retirement systems which are in addition to any payments required for the
21	annual amortization of the unfunded accrued liability of the public retirement
22	systems, required by Article X, Section 29(E)(2)(c) of the Constitution of Louisiana;
23	however, any such payment to the public retirement systems shall not be used,
24	directly or indirectly, to fund cost-of-living increases for such systems.
25	(c) (b) Providing funding for capital outlay projects in the comprehensive
26	state budget.
27	(d) (c) Providing for allocation or appropriation for deposit into the Wetlands
28	Conservation and Restoration Fund established in Article VII, Section 10.2 of the
29	Constitution of Louisiana.

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1	(e) (d) Providing for new highway construction for which federal matching
2	funds are available, without excluding highway projects otherwise eligible as capital
3	projects under other provisions of law.
4	* * *
5	Section 2. This Act shall take effect and become operative if and when the proposed
6	amendment of Article VII, Section 10(D)(2)(b) of the Constitution of Louisiana contained
7	in the Act which originated as House Bill No. 384 of this 2011 Regular Session of the
8	Legislature is adopted at the statewide election to be held on October 22, 2011, and becomes
9	effective.
