SUNSET LAW: Re-creates the Department of Public Safety and Corrections

1	AN ACT		
2	To enact R.S. 49:191(2)(b) and to repeal R.S. 49:191(12)(d), relative to the Department of		
3	Public Safety and Corrections, including provisions to provide for the re-creation of		
4	the Department of Public Safety and Corrections and the statutory entities made a		
5	part of the department by law; to provide for the effective termination date for all		
6	statutory authority for the existence of such statutory entities; to provide for an		
7	effective date; and to provide for related matters.		
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:		
9	Section 1. Pursuant to R.S. 49:193, the Department of Public Safety and Corrections		
10	and the statutory entities made a part of the department by law shall be re-created effective		
11	June 30, 2024, and all statutory authority therefor is continued in accordance with the		
12	provisions of Part XII of Chapter 1 of Title 49 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950.		
13	Section 2. All statutory authority for the existence of the Department of Public		
14	Safety and Corrections and the statutory entities made a part of the department as re-created		
15	by Section 1 of this Act shall cease as of July 1, 2029, pursuant to R.S. 49:191. However,		
16	the Department of Public Safety and Corrections may be re-created prior to such date in		
17	accordance with the provisions of Part XII of Chapter 1 of Title 49 of the Louisiana Revised		
18	Statutes of 1950.		
19	Section 3. The provisions of R.S. 49:193 are hereby superseded to the extent that		
20	those provisions are in conflict with the provisions of this Act.

1	Section 4. R.S. 49:191(2)(b) is hereby enacted to read as follows:			
2	§191. Termination of legislative authority for existence of statutory entities; phase-			
3	out period for statutory entities; table of dates			
4	Notwithstanding any termination dates set by any previous Act of the			
5	legislature, the statutory entities set forth in this Section shall begin to terminate their			
6	operations on July first of each of the following years, and all legislative authority			
7	for the existence of any statutory entity, as defined in R.S. 49:190, shall cease as of			
8	July first of the following year, which shall be the termination date:

10	(2) July 1, 2028:

12	(b) The Department of Public Safety and Corrections and all statutory			
13	entities made a part of the department by law.			
14	Section 5. R.S. 49:191(12)(d) is hereby repealed in its entirety.			
15	Section 6. This Act shall become effective on June 30, 2024; if vetoed by the			
16	governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective or			
17 June 30, 2024, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever i

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Abstract: Re-creates the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections for four more years. Changes termination date <u>from</u> July 1, 2025 to July 1, 2029.

<u>Present law</u> ("Sunset" law) provides that the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections and all the statutory entities made a part of the department by law shall begin to terminate their operations on July 1, 2024, and that all legislative authority for such entities shall cease as of July 1, 2025, unless the legislature enacts a bill authorizing the re-creation of the department and its statutory entities prior thereto.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the general re-creation of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections and its statutory entities, effective June 30, 2024, in accordance with the Sunset law. Supersedes the provisions of the Sunset law which set out the procedure for review and re-creation and which require a separate bill to re-create each statutory entity within the department along with additional provisions. July 1, 2029, is the new termination date, and termination would begin July 1, 2028, unless the department is again re-created.
