HIGHWAYS: Redesignates a portion of Louisiana Highway 563 in Lincoln Parish as the "Johnny Lynn Cole Memorial Highway"

1 AN ACT

2 To redesignate a portion of Louisiana Highway 563 near Simsboro, Louisiana, in Lincoln
3 Parish as the "Johnny Lynn Cole Memorial Highway"; and to provide for related
4 matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. The portion of Louisiana Highway 563 between Louisiana Highway 150
7 and Interstate 20 near Simsboro, Louisiana, in Lincoln Parish shall be known and hereby
8 redesignated as the "Johnny Lynn Cole Memorial Highway".

9 Section 2. The Department of Transportation and Development or its contractors are
10 hereby directed to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this designation
11 provided local or private monies are received by the department equal to the department's
12 actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to
13 exceed the sum of five hundred fifty dollars per sign.

Redesignates the portion of LA 563 between LA 150 and I-20 near Simsboro, La., in Lincoln Parish as the "Johnny Lynn Cole Memorial Highway".

Directs the Dept. of Transportation and Development (DOTD) to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting the highway designation provided local or private monies are

received by DOTD equal to its actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to exceed the sum of \$550 per sign.
