AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 17:1601.8, relative to naming of state buildings after living persons; to provide 3 that the baseball operational center at Southern University at Baton Rouge be named 4 the Cador Baseball Operational Center; and to provide for related matters. 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: Section 1. R.S. 17:1601.8 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 6 7 §1601.8. Cador Baseball Operational Center The baseball operational center located on the Baton Rouge campus of 8 9 Southern University, operated by and under the authority of the Board of Supervisors 10 of Southern University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, is designated and 11 shall be known as the "Cador Baseball Operational Center". 12 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 13 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 14 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If

2	effective on the day following such approval.
