NURSES/REGISTERED: Provides relative to advanced practice registered nursing

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 37:913.1, relative to advanced practice registered nursing; to provide relative  
3 to collaborative practice agreements between advanced practice registered nurses and  
4 physicians or dentists; to create a limited exception to requirements relative to such  
5 agreements; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 37:913.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 §913.1. Collaborative practice requirements; limitation

9 No provision of R.S. 37:913 that requires a collaborative practice agreement  
10 shall apply to any advanced practice registered nurse who is lawfully performing his  
11 advanced practice registered nursing duties in a hospital licensed in accordance with  
12 R.S. 40:2100 et seq. or in a nursing facility licensed in accordance with R.S.  
13 40:2009.1 et seq.

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**Abstract:** Creates a limited exception to requirements relative to collaborative practice agreements between advanced practice registered nurses and physicians or dentists.

Present law requires advanced practice registered nurses to practice in accordance with collaborative practice agreements with licensed physicians or dentists.

Proposed law creates a limited exception to such collaborative practice agreement requirements for advanced practice registered nurses who perform their advanced practice registered nursing duties in a hospital or nursing facility licensed in accordance with present law.
