PARDON: Establishes a fee for conducting pardon investigations

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 15:572.5, relative to pardons; to provide for information to be
3	provided to the Board of Pardons; to establish a fee for conducting pardon
4	investigations; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 15:572.5 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§572.5. Information to be provided to Board of Pardons
8	A. Upon request of the Board of Pardons, the Department of Corrections and
9	the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall provide the Board of Pardons
10	with such records of the fact and circumstances of the offense for which the person
11	applying for a pardon was convicted, the offender's past criminal record, his social
12	history, the prison record, and the physical, mental, or psychiatric condition of the
13	person applying for a pardon, and any other records or other reports that may be
14	requested.
15	B. The Department of Public Safety and Corrections may charge a fee not
16	to exceed one hundred fifty dollars for conducting the clemency investigation
17	provided for in this Section.
