HOUSE BILL NO. 498

BY REPRESENTATIVE TEMPLET

Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR: Relative to the legislative auditor, requires the auditor to inform an entity that distributes funds to an auditee if auditee fails to file financial statements and requires auditees to designate an individual to file reports with the auditor and notify the auditor

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 24:513(H) and to enact R.S. 24:513(D)(6), relative to the
3 legislative auditor; to require notification to certain entities that distribute funds to
4 an auditee when the auditee fails to comply with requirements for filing reports and
5 submitting information to the auditor; to require auditees to designate an individual
6 responsible for filing annual financial reports and to notify the auditor of such
7 designation; and to provide for related matters.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 24:513(H) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 24:513(D)(6)
10 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

11 §513. Powers and duties of legislative auditor; audit reports as public records;
12 assistance and opinions of attorney general; frequency of audits; subpoena

15 D. In addition, the legislative auditor shall perform the following duties and

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

1. Limits the entities that the legislative auditor is required under proposed law to notify to officials or agencies of local or state government.
