SALES/TOBACCO TRADE: Prohibits alcoholic beverage and tobacco licensees from accepting food stamps as payment for products

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. $26:90(A)(12)$ and $286(A)(12)$ and to enact R.S. $26:911(A)(5)$ and
3	(6), relative to the sale of alcoholic beverages and tobacco products; to prohibit the
4	acceptance of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program electronic benefit cards
5	as payment for tobacco products; to prohibit certain illegal activities involving
6	controlled dangerous substances on or about a licensed premises; to make technical
7	changes to corresponding provisions in the Alcoholic Beverage Control Law; and to
8	provide for related matters.
9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
0	Section 1. R.S. 26:90(A)(12) and 286(A)(12) are hereby amended and reenacted and
1	R.S. 26:911(A)(5) and (6) are hereby enacted to read as follows:

Arnold HB No. 522

Abstract: Prohibits the acceptance of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) electronic benefit cards for the purchase of tobacco products and prohibits certain illegal activities involving controlled dangerous substances on licensed premises.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits persons holding a retail dealer's permit from accepting food stamps as payment for alcoholic beverages in violation of federal law.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and changes the reference <u>from</u> "food stamps" <u>to</u> "Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) electronic benefit cards" and corrects the citation to federal law.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits any person, agent, associate, employee, representative, or servant of any person from accepting Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) electronic benefit cards for the purchase of tobacco products on or about any premises which sell or offers for sale tobacco products.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the illegal selling, offering for sale, possession, or the consumption of any type of controlled substance on or about any premises licensed to sell tobacco products.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Judiciary</u> to the <u>original</u> bill.

- 1. Changed all references <u>from</u> "food stamp coupons" <u>to</u> "Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) electronic benefit transfer cards".
- 2. Added a prohibition on certain illegal activities involving controlled dangerous substances on or about premises licensed to sell tobacco products.
- 3. Made technical amendments.
