## TRANSPORTATION: Requires the implementation of a Complete Streets plan

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 48:21(B) and 163.1(A)(1)(introductory paragraph) and (2) and
3	(D), relative to bicycle facilities; to provide for a certain amount of funds to be used
4	on bicycle facilities; to provide for guidelines for when bicycle facilities are to be
5	constructed; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 48:21(B) and 163.1(A)(1)(introductory paragraph) and (2) and (D)
8	are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

11	B. The department may shall construct and maintain within the right-of-way
12	of any state highway or section thereof bicycle facilities appropriate to the context
13	of the roadway in accordance with R.S. 48:163.1. If such facilities are not included
14	in new construction projects, the department shall document the reasons for the

17	§163.1. Use of highway funds for bicycle facilities
18	A.(1) The department annually may shall expend a reasonable amount of the
19	transportation trust fund for the establishment, construction, and maintenance of

Abstract: Requires DOTD to construct bicycle facilities.

<u>Present law</u> provides that DOTD may construct and maintain within the right-of-way of any state highway or section thereof bicycle facilities appropriate to the context of the roadway.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that DOTD shall construct and maintain within the right-of-way of any state highway or section thereof bicycle facilities appropriate to the context of the roadway.

<u>Present law</u> provides that DOTD annually may expend a reasonable amount of the transportation trust fund for the establishment, construction, and maintenance of bicycle facilities. Bicycle facilities may be established wherever a highway, road, or street is being constructed, reconstructed, relocated, or as separate projects, unless DOTD makes certain determinations regarding existing prohibitions, needs, and expenses.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that DOTD annually shall expend a reasonable amount of the transportation trust fund for the establishment, construction, and maintenance of bicycle facilities. Bicycle facilities shall be established wherever a highway, road, or street is being

constructed, reconstructed, relocated, or as separate projects, unless DOTD makes certain determinations regarding needs and expenses.

<u>Present law</u> provides that bicycle facilities shall not be constructed in conjunction with preservation projects if the construction of the facility requires right-of-way acquisition, utility relocation, or major construction.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that unless DOTD makes certain determinations regarding needs and expenses, bicycle facilities shall be constructed in conjunction with preservation projects.
