To amend and reenact R.S. 49:953(H) and R.S. 56:332(A), relative to the taking of crabs; to provide for the promulgation of rules and regulations relative to blue crab season;

to provide for the authority to close the harvest of crabs; and to provide for related

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 49:953(H) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§953. Procedure for adoption of rules

9 * * *

H. The Department of Wildlife and Fisheries and the Louisiana Wildlife and Fisheries Commission may employ the timetables and provisions of Subsection B of this Section in promulgating rules and regulations relative to hunting seasons, trapping seasons, alligator seasons, shrimp seasons, oysters seasons, <u>blue crab season</u>, and finfish seasons and size limits, and all rules and regulations pursuant thereto. Rules adopted annually pursuant to this Subsection which open and close the offshore and fall shrimp seasons, the oyster seasons, <u>the blue crab season</u>, the marine finfish seasons, the webless migratory game bird hunting season, and the trapping season shall be effective for the duration of the respective season. Notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraph (B)(4) of this Section, any legislative oversight hearing held on a rule proposed under the provisions of this Subsection

6	A.(1) The commission shall have the authority to close all or parts of inside
7	and outside waters as it deems appropriate upon inspection of and based upon
8	technical and biological data which indicates that such action is necessary to
9	maintain crabs in sufficient quantities for future harvest. In making this
10	determination, the commission shall consider biological sustainability as identified
11	in the most current assessment for crabs in Louisiana and shall consider
12	recommendations from the department.
13	(2) Crabs of legal size may be taken using any gear identified in R.S.
14	56:320(B)(3); however, the taking of crabs by means of trawls in inside waters is
15	permitted only during the open season for shrimp. In no event, however, shall a
16	person use a trawl with a mesh size less than that of commercial shrimp trawls for
17	the purpose of taking crabs during the open season for shrimp.

Abstract: Authorizes the WLF Commission to set the crab season.

<u>Present law</u> in APA authorized agencies to adopt emergency rules because of imminent peril to the public health, safety, or welfare, or to the extent necessary to avoid sanctions or penalties from the U.S., or to avoid a budget deficit in the case of medical assistance programs or to secure new or enhanced federal funding in medical assistance programs.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the department and commission to employ the timetables and provisions of <u>present law</u> (R.S. 49:953(B)) in promulgating rules and regulations relative to hunting seasons, trapping seasons, alligator seasons, shrimp seasons, oyster seasons, finfish seasons and size limits, and all rules and regulations pursuant thereto. Further provides that rules adopted annually which open and close the offshore and fall shrimp seasons, the oyster seasons, the marine finfish seasons, the webless migratory game bird hunting season, and

the trapping season shall be effective for the duration of the respective season. Provides that any legislative oversight hearing held on a rule proposed under <u>present law</u> shall be held no earlier than five days and not later than 30 days following the date of adoption of the rule.

Proposed law retains present law and adds blue crab season.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the commission to close all or parts of inside and outside waters as it deems appropriate upon inspection of and based upon technical and biological data to maintain crabs in sufficient quantities for future harvest.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the commission to consider biological sustainability as identified in the most current assessment for crabs in La. and to consider recommendations from the department.

<u>Present law</u> provides for gear used to harvest crabs. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.
