8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 33:9078(F)(4)(c) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as
10	follows:

17	(c) The fee shall expire on December 31, 2010, but the fee may be renewed,
18	the amount of the fee provided in Paragraph (2) of this Subsection may be changed,
19	or a maximum fee amount in excess of the amount of the fee provided in Paragraph
20	(2) of this Subsection may be established, if approved by a majority of the registered
21	voters of the district voting on the proposition at an election as provided in
22	Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph held for that purpose in accordance with the
23	Louisiana Election Code. Any election to authorize renewal of the fee, to change the
24	amount of the fee, or to establish a new maximum fee amount shall be held only at

1	the same time as the mayoral primary election for the city of New Orleans. If the fee
2	is renewed, if the amount of fee is changed with voter approval, or if a new
3	maximum fee amount is established, the term of the imposition of the fee shall be as
4	provided in the proposition authorizing such renewal, change in fee amount, or
5	maximum fee amount, not to exceed eight years. If a new maximum fee amount is
6	established as provided in this Subparagraph, the amount of the fee shall be
7	determined and such amount may be changed by duly adopted resolution of the
8	board without the necessity of an election, provided that the fee amount shall not
9	exceed the maximum fee amount and the term of imposition shall not exceed the
10	term of imposition established with voter approval.

12	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
13	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
14	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
15	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
16	effective on the day following such approval.
