AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 32:424(A), relative to driver's licenses; to require a suspected 3 unqualified licensee to retake the skills and knowledge test; and to provide for 4 related matters. 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 6 Section 1. R.S. 32:424(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 7 §424. Department may compel examination of suspected incompetents; prohibited 8 disclosure of information; exceptions 9 A. The department, having good cause to believe that a licensed driver or 10 chauffeur is incompetent or otherwise not qualified to be licensed, may upon written 11 notice of at least ten days to the licensee require him to submit to the knowledge or 12 and skills test required for issuance of a driver's license, or submit to a medical 13 examination. Upon the conclusion of such test or examination, the department shall 14 take action as may be appropriate, including permitting the licensee to retain the 15 license or suspending, revoking, or restricting the license. Refusal or neglect of the 16 licensee to submit to the knowledge or skills test or a medical examination shall be 17 grounds for suspension or revocation of his license. 18

Montoucet HB No. 544

Abstract: Requires those suspected of being incompetent or otherwise unfit to be licensed undergo the department knowledge and skills tests required of issuance of a driver's license in this state.

<u>Present law</u> requires a licensed driver suspected of being incompetent or otherwise not qualified to be licensed to undergo the department knowledge or skills test required for issuance of a driver's license.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that a licensed driver suspected of being incompetent or otherwise not qualified to be licensed to undergo the department knowledge and skills test required for issuance of a driver's license.
