R.S. 33:2957 is hereby enacted to read as follows: §2957. Investments of hospital service districts 8 9 Any hospital service district may invest its funds as provided by R.S. 10 46:1073.1, except as provided therein. 11 Section 2. R.S. 46:1073.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 12 §1073.1. Hospital service districts; investments 13 A. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, a hospital service 14 district may invest its funds as provided by law for investment of funds of the 15 Louisiana State Employees Retirement System, including but not limited to R.S. 16 11:263; however, any such investment may be made only in compliance with rules 17 and regulations established by the hospital service district commission and in 18 compliance with the provisions of R.S. 11:263 and any other law which provides for 19 investments in which funds of the Louisiana State Employees Retirement System 20 may be invested. 21 B. This Section shall be applicable to a hospital service district as defined 22 in R.S. 46:1072, other than a hospital owned by the state.
