MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC: Provides for an additional fee on driver's license applications to benefit the Military Family Assistance Fund

AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 32:412(A)(1), (2), (5), and (6) and (B)(1), (2), and (7)(e)(i)(aa), 3 (cc), (dd)(I), (ee), (ii)(aa), (cc), (dd)(I), and (ee) and R.S. 46:122(A)(1), relative to 4 driver's license fees; to provide for a one dollar increase in driver's license fees to 5 benefit the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund; and to provide for related 6 matters. 7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 8 Section 1. R.S. 32:412(A)(1), (2), (5), and (6) and (B)(1), (2), and (7)(e)(i)(aa), (cc), 9 (dd)(I), (ee), (ii)(aa), (cc), (dd)(I), and (ee) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as 10 follows: 11 §412. Amount of fees; credit or refund; duration of license; veteran designation; 12 disabled veteran designation; university logo; "I'm a Cajun" designation; 13 disbursement of funds; renewal by mail or electronic commerce of Class "D" 14 or "E" drivers' licenses; disposition of certain fees; exception 15 A.(1) Every applicant for a Class "D" driver's license, or for a renewal of a 16 Class "D" driver's license, except those bona fide residents of the city of New 17 Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of forty-two forty-three dollars and 18 seventy-five cents. Eleven dollars and fifteen cents of the fee shall be paid to the 19 Louisiana State Police Retirement System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee 20 shall be forwarded by the department to the litter abatement and education account

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which is created with the Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.

(2) The fee for Class "D" driver's licenses, or renewal of a Class "D" driver's license, issued to bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans shall be fifty-four fifty-five dollars, fifteen dollars of which shall be payable by the department to the board of trustees of the police pension fund of the city of New Orleans. One dollar and eighty-four cents of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana State Police Retirement System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the department to the litter abatement and education account which is created within the Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.

- (5) Every applicant for a Class "E" driver's license, or for a renewal of a Class "E" driver's license, except those bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of twenty twenty-one dollars and twenty-five cents, which shall be the cost of such basic license. Five dollars and sixty-three cents of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana State Police Retirement System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the department to the litter abatement and education account which is created within the Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.
- (6) The fee for a Class "E" driver's license, or renewal of a Class "E" driver's license, issued to bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans shall be twenty twenty-one dollars and twenty-five cents, three dollars and seventy-five cents of which fee shall be paid by the department to the board of trustees of the police pension funds of the city of New Orleans. Three dollars and seventy-five cents of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana State Police Retirement System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the department to the litter

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5	B.(1) Every applicant for a Class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's

7	license, except for those bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for
8	such basic license a fee of sixty-one sixty-two dollars and fifty cents. Sixteen dollars
9	and twenty cents of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana State Police Retirement
10	System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the
11	department to the litter abatement and education account which is created within the
12	Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of the
13	fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.
14	(2) The fee for a basic Class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license,
15	or for the renewal of a basic Class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license,
16	issued to bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans shall be seventy-six
17	seventy-seven dollars and fifty cents, fifteen dollars of which fee shall be paid by the
18	department to the board of trustees of the police pension fund of the city of New
19	Orleans. Fifteen dollars of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana State Police
20	Retirement System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by
21	the department to the litter abatement and education account which is created with
22	the Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of

27	(e)(i)(aa) Every applicant seventy years of age or older for a Class "E"
28	driver's license, or for the renewal of a Class "E" driver's license, except those bona
29	fide residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of six

seven dollars and seventy-five cents, which shall be the cost of the license. The license shall expire on the anniversary of the birthday of the applicant which is nearest to a date of six years subsequent to the issuing of the license, unless revoked, canceled, or suspended.

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(cc) Seventy-five cents of the fee shall be paid to the office of state police. Two dollars and seventy-five cents of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana State Police Retirement System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the department to the litter abatement and education account which is created within the Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.

(dd)(I) Every applicant seventy years of age or older for a Class "D" driver's license, or for the renewal of a Class "D" driver's license, except those bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of twenty-two twenty-three dollars and thirteen cents, which shall be the cost of the license. The license shall expire on the anniversary of the birthday of the applicant which is nearest to the date of six years subsequent to the issuing of the license, unless revoked, canceled, or suspended.

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(ee) Five dollars and fifty-six cents of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana State Police Pension and Retirement System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the department to the litter abatement and education account which is created within the Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.

(ii)(aa) Every applicant seventy years of age or older for a Class "E" driver's license, or for the renewal of a Class "E" driver's license, issued to bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of six seven dollars and seventy-five cents, which shall be the cost of the license. This

license shall expire on the anniversary of the birthday of the applicant which is nearest to a date of six years subsequent to the issuing of the license, unless revoked, canceled, or suspended.

* * * *

(cc) One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be paid to the Board of Trustees of the Police Pension Fund of the city of New Orleans. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be paid to the State Police Pension and Retirement Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the department to the litter abatement and education account which is created within the Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.

(dd)(I) Every applicant seventy years of age or older for a Class "D" driver's license, or for the renewal of a Class "D" driver's license, issued to bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of twenty-seven twenty-eight dollars and seventy-five cents, which shall be the cost of the license. This license shall expire on the anniversary of the birthday of the applicant which is nearest to the date of six years subsequent to the issuing of the license, unless revoked, canceled, or suspended.

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(ee) Seven dollars and fifty cents of the fee shall be payable by the department to the board of trustees of the police pension fund of the city of New Orleans. Ninety-two cents of the fee shall be paid to the State Police Pension and Retirement Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the department to the litter abatement and education account which is created within the Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.

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Section 2. R.S. 46:122(A)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: §122. Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund A.(1) Funds received by the state treasurer pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 4 47:120.31 and 306.3, or received by the treasurer or the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Board from other public or private donations, gifts, grants, appropriations or other revenue, including revenue derived from driver's license fees, shall be 7 deposited and credited to a special fund hereby created in the state treasury to be 8 known as the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund. The money in the fund shall be used solely as provided for in Subsection B of this Section. In addition to funds from any other source, public or private donations, gifts, or grants from 10 individuals, corporations, nonprofit organizations, or other business entities may be 12 made to the fund and accepted by the fund for military family relief and assistance as provided in this Part. 14

Proposed law modifies present law by increasing the class "D" driver's license fee from \$42.75 to \$43.75. Proposed law further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the La. Military Family Assistance Fund (fund).

Present law provides for a class "D" driver's license fee of \$54.00 for residents of the city of New Orleans. Present law further provides for the distribution of the fee according to present law.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license fee of \$61.50, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee according to present law.

<u>Proposed law modifies present law</u> by increasing the class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license fee <u>from</u> \$61.50 <u>to</u> \$62.50. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the fund.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license fee of \$76.50 for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee according to present law.

<u>Proposed law modifies present law</u> by increasing the class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license fee <u>from</u> \$76.50 to \$77.50. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the fund.

<u>Present law</u> provides for applicants 70 years or older a class "E" driver's license fee of \$6.75, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee according to <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> modifies <u>present law</u> by increasing the fee for applicants 70 years or older for a class "E" driver's license <u>from</u> \$6.75 <u>to</u> \$7.75. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the fund.

<u>Present law</u> provides for applicants 70 years or older a class "D" driver's license fee of \$22.13, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee according to <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> modifies <u>present law</u> by increasing the fee for applicants 70 years or older for a class "D" driver's license <u>from</u> \$22.13 <u>to</u> \$23.13. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the fund.

<u>Present law</u> provides for applicants 70 years or older, and a resident of the city of New Orleans, a class "E" driver's license fee of \$6.75. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee according to <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law modifies present law</u> by increasing the fee for applicants 70 years or older for a class "E" driver's license <u>from</u> \$6.75 <u>to</u> \$7.75. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the fund.

<u>Present law</u> provides for applicants 70 years or older, and a resident of the city of New Orleans, a class "D" driver's license fee of \$27.75. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee according to <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> provides for funds received pursuant to <u>present law</u> to be deposited to the La. Military Family Assistance Fund.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds the revenue derived from <u>proposed law</u> to the funds deposited in the La. Military Family Assistance Fund.
