## UNEMPLOYMENT COMP: Requires employers to submit wage information to the LA Workforce Commission when submitting unemployment compensation insurance quarterly reports

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 23:1660(A), relative to employment records; to provide for
3	certain occupational data when filing quarterly reports; to provide for improved
4	workforce development and educational alignment; and to provide for related
5	matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 23:1660(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§1660. Employment records and reports; inspection by administrator;
9	confidentiality of records; prohibition against subpoena
10	A.(1) Each employing unit shall keep true and accurate records containing
11	such information as the administrator may prescribe. Such records shall be open to
12	inspection and be subject to being copied by the administrator or his authorized
13	representatives at any time and as often as may be necessary. In addition to
14	information prescribed by the administrator, each employer shall keep records of and
15	report to the administrator quarterly the street address of each establishment, branch,
16	outlet, or office of such employer, the nature of the operation, the number of persons
17	employed, each employee's wages, and the wages paid at each establishment, branch,
18	outlet, or office.

1	(2) When filing quarterly wage reports, each employing unit shall include
2	occupational data, including Standard Occupation Classification System codes and
3	job titles of employees reported by employers. The commission shall share this data
4	with the Louisiana Board of Regents and the Workforce Investment Council to aid
5	in improved workforce development and educational alignment.

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Abstract: Requires employing units to include additional information when submitting quarterly reports.

<u>Present law</u> requires each employing unit to keep records of the address of each establishment, the nature of the operation, the number of employees, and the wages paid, and to make the records available for inspection to the administrator, as well as to submit them quarterly to the La. Workforce Commission.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds to the type of records that shall be maintained and submitted to include the wages of each employee, Standard Occupation Classification Systems codes, and job titles.

<u>Proposed law</u> further requires that the information required to be reported to the La. Workforce Commission in <u>proposed law</u> be sent to the La. Board of Regents and the Workforce Investment Council to aid in improved workforce development and educational alignment.
