LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTS: Repeals provisions relative to landscape horticulturists

AN ACT

8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 3:3801(A)(introductory paragraph) is hereby amended and reenacted
10	to read as follows:
11	§3801. Horticulture Commission
12	A. The Horticulture Commission of Louisiana is hereby created within the
13	Department of Agriculture and Forestry to be comprised of the following thirteen
14	members:

16	Section 2. R.S. 3:3801(A)(7) and (C)(4), 3804(A)(4), 3807(B)(4), 3808(D) and 3815
17	are hereby repealed in their entirety.
18	Section 3. Any rule or regulation promulgated by the Department of Agriculture and
19	Forestry providing for the regulation, examination, and licensing of landscape horticulturists
20	shall be null, void, and without effect upon the effective date of this Act. The Department

- 1 of Agriculture and Forestry shall issue a notice of intent to amend their rules and regulations
- 2 in conformity with this Act on or before September 1, 2018 and adopt the amended rules and
- 3 regulations on or before December 1, 2018.
- 4 Section 4. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
- 5 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
- by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
- 7 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
- 8 effective on the day following such approval.

**Abstract:** Repeals the regulation, examination, and licensing of landscape horticulturists.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes a landscape horticulturist do the following: (1) implement designs prepared by a licensed landscape architect, (2) recommend and implement measures for interior and exterior beautification, (3) sell, lease, or maintain nursery stock, and prepare drawings to indicate the placement of nursery stock.

<u>Present law</u> establishes the regulation, examination, and licensing landscape horticulturists. <u>Proposed law</u> repeals <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> establishes the membership of the Horticulture Commission that includes a landscape horticulturists. Proposed law repeals present law.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes a person holding either a horticulturist license or landscape contractor's license prior to Feb. 1, 2009 to renew his license as a landscape horticulturist license without further application or examination upon the payment of any required renewal fee. <u>Proposed law</u> repeals <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> declares that any rule or regulation providing for the regulation, examination, and licensing of landscape horticulturists are null, void, and without effect upon the effective date of proposed law.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the department to issue a notice of intent to amend their rules and regulations in conformity with <u>proposed law</u> on or before Sept. 1, 2018 and adopt same on or before Dec. 1, 2018.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
