## JUVENILE PROCEDURE: Provides relative to the dismissal of a petition for families in need of services

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact Children's Code Article 763, relative to families in need of services
3	proceedings; to provide relative to motions to dismiss a petition for families in need
4	of services; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. Children's Code Article 763 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as
7	follows:
8	Art. 763. Motions to dismiss
9	<u>A.</u> All objections to the proceedings, including objections based on defects
10	in the petition and defenses capable of determination as a matter of law, may be
11	raised by motion to dismiss.
12	B. Upon a finding of grounds to dismiss the petition as provided for in
13	Paragraph A of this Article, the court shall order that the petition be dismissed.

Abstract: Provides relative to the court's authority to dismiss a petition for families in need of services.

With regard to Families in Need of Services (FINS) proceedings, <u>present law</u> provides that all objections to the proceedings, including objections based on defects in the petition and defenses capable of determination as a matter of law, may be raised by motion to dismiss.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds that upon a finding of grounds to dismiss the petition as provided for in <u>present law</u>, the court shall order that the petition be dismissed.
