INSURANCE CLAIMS: Clarifies terms relative to duties to report insurance fraud

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 22:1926(A), relative to insurance fraud; to clarify terms relative

3 to insurance fraud; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

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Section 1. R.S. 22:1926(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§1926. Duties of companies and others

A. Any person, company, or other legal entity including but not limited to those engaged in the business of insurance, including agents, brokers, and adjusters, which believes suspects that a fraudulent claim insurance act will be, is being, or has been committed is being made, shall, within sixty days of the receipt of such notice, send to the section of insurance fraud, on a form prescribed by the section, the information requested and such additional information relative to the claim insurance act and the parties claiming loss or damages because of an occurrence or accident as the section may require. The section of insurance fraud shall review such reports and select such claims insurance acts as, in its judgment, may require further investigation. It shall then cause an independent examination of the facts surrounding such claim insurance act to be made to determine the extent, if any, to which fraud, deceit, or intentional misrepresentation of any kind exists in the submission of the claim insurance act.

**Abstract:** Clarifies terms relative to insurance fraud.

<u>Present law</u> provides that any person, company, or other legal entity which believes that a fraudulent claim is being made, shall report it to the insurance fraud section of the Dept. of Insurance within 60 days on a form prescribed by the section. The insurance fraud section will review the report and determine whether fraud has been committed.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes and broadens the relevant terminology <u>from</u> a "fraudulent claim" that is being made <u>to</u> a "fraudulent act" that will be, is being, or has been committed.

Provides that any person, company, or legal entity that suspects that a fraudulent act, not only a claim, will be, is being, or has been committed shall report such suspicion to the insurance fraud section.
