2	To enact R.S. 9:2800.23, relative to certain causes of action; to provide for a cause of action
3	for parishes, municipalities, and other political subdivisions under certain
4	circumstances; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 9:2800.23 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	<u>§2800.23. Actions by governing authorities; attorney fees</u>
8	In the case of any accident, disaster, or emergency, whether designated a
9	disaster or emergency or not, if a parish, municipality, or political subdivision incurs
10	damages, costs, or expenses of any type, including economic damages, in connection
11	therewith or as a result thereof, there shall exist a cause of action by the parish,
12	municipality, or political subdivision for the recovery of such damages, costs, and
13	expenses against any and all parties responsible for such accident, disaster, or
14	emergency, who shall additionally be liable for the reasonable attorney fees of the
15	parish, municipality, or political subdivision incurred in connection with such
16	recovery.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides a cause of action for parishes, municipalities, or other political subdivisions for any damages incurred, including economic damages, in the case of any accident, disaster, or emergency, whether declared an emergency or not, if a parish, municipality, or political subdivision incurs damages, costs, or expenses of any type.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for an award of reasonable attorney fees incurred in connection with the recovery of damages.
