2	To enact Code of Criminal Procedure Article 334.4, relative to bail; to provide for the		
3	reinstatement of bail in certain cases; to provide for the circumstances in which bail		
4	may be reinstated; to provide for the adoption of rules; and to provide for related		
5	matters.		
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:		
7	Section 1. Code of Criminal Procedure Article 334.4 is hereby enacted to read as		
8	follows:		
9	Art. 334.4. Reinstatement of bail following dismissal of case by prosecution;		
10	conditions		
11	A. When the district attorney dismisses an indictment or information and		
12	institutes a subsequent indictment or information for the same offense or for a lesser		
13	offense based on the same facts, the court shall reinstate any bail discharged when		
14	the district attorney dismissed the initial indictment or information if the surety		
15	consents to the reinstatement expressly and in writing.		
16	B. Orleans Parish district judges with criminal jurisdiction sitting en banc		
17	may adopt rules effectuating telephonic communication and verification of bonds		
18	and releases.		

[C. Nothing in this Article limits the court's authority to increase or reduce		
2	bail pursuant to Article 342.
