## CONSUMERS/PROTECTION: Provides relative to prohibitions on a local governing authority regulating online marketplaces

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 51:3267, relative to online marketplace services; to prohibit certain regulating
3	of local governing authorities; to provide for definitions; and to provide for related
4	matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 51: 3267 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§3267. Regulating online marketplaces; prohibitions; local governing authorities
8	A. As used in this Section:
9	(1) "Local governing authority" means the legislative body of a city,
10	municipality, parish, or other political subdivision of this state.
11	(2) "Online marketplace" has the meaning ascribed it in R.S. 51:3261 and
12	includes a person or entity that does either of the following:
13	(a) Provides for consideration, regardless of whether the consideration is
14	deducted as a fee from the transaction, an online application, software, website,
15	system, or other medium, through which a service in this state is advertised or
16	offered to the public as available.
17	(b) Directly or indirectly provides or maintains a platform for services by
18	performing any of the following:
19	(i) Providing a payment system that facilitates a transaction between two
20	platform users.

CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

1	(ii) Transmitting or otherwise communicating the offer or acceptance of a
2	transaction between two platform users.
3	(iii) Owning or operating the electronic infrastructure, or technology that
4	brings two or more users together.
5	(c) The term "online marketplace" shall not include any local or state
6	governmental entity or vendor.
7	B. A local governing authority shall not do either of the following:
8	(1) Regulate the operation of an online marketplace.
9	(2) Require an online marketplace to provide personally identifiable
10	information of users without an administrative subpoena or court order.

Abstract: Prohibits a local governing authority from regulating the operation of an online marketplace.

Proposed law defines "local governing authority" and "online marketplace".

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that an online marketplace is a person or entity that provides for payment for goods or services and provides or maintains a platform for services.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that online marketplace does not include any local or state governmental entity or vendor.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that a local governing authority shall not regulate the operation of an online marketplace or require an online marketplace to provide the personal identification of users without a subpoena or court order.
