| 7 | Section 1. R.S. 56:322.2(A) and (D) are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. |
| 8 | 56:322.2(C)(3) is hereby enacted to read as follows: |
| 9 | §322.2. Shad gill nets; commercial harvest of shad and skipjack herring |
| 10 | A. A commercial fisherman licensed in accordance with R.S. 56:303 and |
| 11 | 305(B)(4)(f) may take shad and skipjack with a shad gill net in accordance with this |
| 12 | Section Lake Palourde, Lake Verret, Lac Des Allemands, all of the waterways in |
| 13 | Iberville Parish, and those portions of the parishes of Iberia, St. Martin, and St. Mary |
| 14 | located between the guide levees of the Atchafalaya Basin but is specifically not |
| 15 | authorized to do so in the streams, bayous, canals, and other water bodies connected |
| 16 | with the specified lakes. |

| 20 | (3) Each shad gill net shall be placed at least fifty feet from the tree |
| 21 | line. |
| 22 | D.(1) The closed season for commercially harvesting shad and skipjack as |
| 23 | provided for in this Section shall include the months of July, August, September, and |
| 24 | October of each year. Except as provided in Paragraph (2) of this Subsection, there |

1 shall be no commercial taking of shad or skipjack pursuant to the provisions of this 2 Section during the period after sunset and before sunrise nor Shad and skipjack may 3 be taken after sunset and before sunrise during open season. However, there shall 4 be no commercial taking of shad or skipjack on any Saturday or Sunday. 5 (2) In Lake Palourde and Lake Verret, shad and skipjack may be taken after 6 sunset and before sunrise during open season. In addition, in Pat's Bay in Iberville 7 Parish from November 1, 2008, through June 31, 2010, shad and skipjack may be 8 taken after sunset and before sunrise during the open season. 9 (3) During the open season, there shall be no daily take or possession limit 10 for the commercial harvest of shad and skipjack by properly licensed shad gill net 11 commercial fishermen. 12 13 Section 2.
