## BY REPRESENTATIVE ABRAMSON

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 42:17(A)(1), 19(A)(1)(b)(i) and (ii)(aa) and (2)(a), and 20(B),
3	relative to the Open Meetings Law; to clarify that certain time periods are exclusive
4	of legal holidays; to require the posting of minutes on the website of a public body
5	under specified circumstances; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 42:17(A)(1), 19(A)(1)(b)(i) and (ii)(aa) and (2)(a), and 20(B) are
8	hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
9	§17. Exceptions to open meetings
10	A. A public body may hold an executive session pursuant to R.S. 42:16 for
11	one or more of the following reasons:
12	(1) Discussion of the character, professional competence, or physical or
13	mental health of a person, provided that such person is notified in writing at least
14	twenty-four hours, exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, before the
15	scheduled time contained in the notice of the meeting at which such executive
16	session is to take place and that such person may require that such discussion be held
17	at an open meeting. However, nothing in this Paragraph shall permit an executive
18	session for discussion of the appointment of a person to a public body or, except as
19	provided in R.S. 39:1593(C)(2)(c), for discussing the award of a public contract. In
20	cases of extraordinary emergency, written notice to such person shall not be
21	required; however, the public body shall give such notice as it deems appropriate and
22	circumstances permit.

4	(b)(i) All public bodies, except the legislature and its committees an
5	subcommittees, shall give written public notice of any regular, special, or
6	rescheduled meeting no later than twenty-four hours, exclusive of Saturdays
7	Sundays, and legal holidays, before the meeting.
8	(ii)(aa) Such notice shall include the agenda, date, time, and place of th
9	meeting. The agenda shall not be changed less than twenty-four hours, exclusive of
10	Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, prior to the scheduled time of the meeting
11	* * *
12	(2) Written public notice given by all public bodies, except the legislatur
13	and its committees and subcommittees, shall include, but need not be limited to:
14	(a) Posting a copy of the notice at the principal office of the public bod
15	holding the meeting, or if no such office exists, at the building in which the meetin
16	is to be held; or by publication of the notice in an official journal of the public bod
17	no less than twenty-four hours, exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays
18	before the scheduled time of the meeting. If the public body has a website
19	additionally by providing notice via the Internet on the website of the public bod
20	for no less than twenty-four hours, exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays, and lega
21	holidays, immediately preceding the meeting. The failure to timely post notice vi
22	the Internet pursuant to this Subparagraph or the inability of the public to access th
23	public body's website due to any type of technological failure shall not be a violatio
24	of the provisions of this Chapter.

§20. Written minutes

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B.(1) The minutes shall be public records and shall be available within a reasonable time after the meeting, except where such disclosures would be

HB NO. 614 **ENROLLED** 1 inconsistent with R.S. 42:16, 17, and 18, or rules adopted under the provisions of 2 R.S. 42:21. 3 (2) If the public body has a website, the public body shall post on its website 4 a copy of the minutes made available pursuant to Paragraph (1) of this Subsection 5 and shall maintain the copy of those minutes on the website for at least three months 6 after the posting. If the public body is required to publish its minutes in an official 7 journal, the public body shall post its minutes on its website as required by this 8 Paragraph within ten days after publication in the official journal. If the public body 9 is not required to publish its minutes in an official journal, the public body shall post 10 its minutes on its website as required by this Paragraph within a reasonable time after 11 the meeting. The inability of the public to access the public body's website due to 12 any type of technological failure shall not be a violation of the provisions of this 13 Chapter.
