## AGRICULTURE: Provides relative to the Commission of Weights and Measures

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 3:4603(E) through (J) and 4633(B) and to enact R.S. 3:4602(22)
3	and 4603(K) and (L), relative to the Commission of Weights and Standards; to
4	provide relative to alternate membership on the commission; to define certain oyster
5	measurements to be enforced by the commission; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 3:4603(E) through (J) and 4633(B) are hereby amended and
8	reenacted and R.S. 3:4602(22) and 4603(K) and (L) are hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	§4602. Definitions
10	As used in this Chapter, the following terms shall have the following
11	meanings:

13	(22) "Basket" means a one and one-half bushel circular container that may
14	be used for the measurement of oysters to be sold or purchased.
15	§4603. Commission of Weights and Measures
16	E. Any vacancy shall be filled in the same manner as the original
17	appointment for the unexpired portion of the term of the office vacated. The
18	commissioner may appoint an alternate member for each member he appoints. The
19	alternate member shall be appointed from the same list of nominees and in the same
20	manner as the appointed member. Any alternate who attends a meeting as a

1	representative of a member shall have the same rights, powers, and privileges,
2	including voting rights, as the member for whom he is an alternate.
3	F. A majority of the members of the commission present at a meeting shall
4	constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. All official actions of the
5	commission shall require the affirmative vote of a majority of the members of the
6	commission present. A member shall be removed from the commission and his seat
7	declared vacant if any of the following apply:
8	(1) The member is no longer a legal resident of the state.
9	(2) The member fails to remain active in the organization he was appointed
10	to represent or is no longer employed by the agency he was appointed to represent.
11	(3) The member is absent from three consecutive meetings within a twelve-
12	month period of time for which the commissioner finds that there are no valid
13	excuses for the absences and the commission chairman verifies the number of
14	unexcused absences.
15	G. Members of the commission shall not receive any salary for their duties
16	as members. Members may receive a per diem for each day spent in actual
17	attendance of meetings of the commission or of duly appointed committees or
18	subcommittees of the commission. The amount of the per diem shall be fixed by the
19	commission in an amount not to exceed forty dollars. Members may receive a
20	mileage allowance for mileage traveled in attending meetings. The mileage
21	allowance shall be fixed by the commission in an amount not to exceed the mileage
22	rate for state employees. E. Any vacancy shall be filled in the same manner as the
23	original appointment for the unexpired portion of the term of the office vacated.
24	H. The commission shall meet two times per year and may meet on the call
25	of the chairman or upon the request of three members or the director. F. A majority
26	of the members of the commission present at a meeting shall constitute a quorum for
27	the transaction of business. All official actions of the commission shall require the
28	affirmative vote of a majority of the members of the commission present.

1 I. The commission shall employ a director and an assistant director, who 2 shall be appointed by the commissioner, subject to Senate confirmation. The director 3 and assistant director shall be in the unclassified service. The commissioner may 4 employ such other personnel of the commission as he deems appropriate. All 5 employees of the commission shall comprise the division of weights and measures 6 in the department and shall be under the direction and supervision of the 7 commissioner. G. Members of the commission shall not receive any salary for their 8 duties as members. Members may receive a per diem for each day spent in actual 9 attendance of meetings of the commission or of duly appointed committees or 10 subcommittees of the commission. The amount of the per diem shall be fixed by the 11 commission in an amount not to exceed forty dollars. Members may receive a 12 mileage allowance for mileage traveled in attending meetings. The mileage 13 allowance shall be fixed by the commission in an amount not to exceed the mileage 14 rate for state employees.

J. Employees of the commission shall possess the authority and powers of
the commission and the commissioner when implementing the provisions of this
Chapter: H. The commission shall meet two times per year and may meet on the
call of the chairman or upon the request of three members or the director.

19K. H. The commission shall employ a director and an assistant director, who20shall be appointed by the commissioner, subject to Senate confirmation. The director21and assistant director shall be in the unclassified service. The commissioner may22employ such other personnel of the commission as he deems appropriate. All23employees of the commission shall comprise the division of weights and measures24in the department and shall be under the direction and supervision of the25commissioner.

<u>L. J.</u> Employees of the commission shall possess the authority and powers
of the commission and the commissioner when implementing the provisions of this
Chapter.

3	B. Each mini-sack of oysters shall contain one-half bushel; each sack of		
4	oysters shall contain one basket one and one-half bushels; and each barrel shall		
5	contain two baskets three bushels. Sacks and barrels shall contain correct		
6	measurements at the time of delivery to the consignee, buyer, or importer and at the		
7	time of delivery to any subsequent buyer after arrival.

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Abstract: Provides relative to alternate members of the Commission of Weights and Measures and measurements for oysters.

<u>Present law</u> provides for ten members appointed by the commissioner of Agriculture and Forestry to the Commission of Weights and Measures. <u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the commissioner to appoint alternates from the same list of nominees in the same manner as each appointed member. Provides that each alternate attending a meeting has the same rights, powers, and privileges as the member, including voting.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the removal from the commission for any member who is no longer a resident of Louisiana, is no longer active in the organization or agency for which he was appointed to represent, or has three or more unexcused absences within a 12-month period of time as verified by the commissioner and the chairman of the commission.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "basket" as a one and one-half bushel container used for measuring oysters for sale or purchase.

<u>Present law</u> requires that each sack of oysters contains one basket and each barrel contains two baskets. <u>Proposed law</u> requires that each mini-sack of oysters contains one-half bushel, each sack contains one and one-half bushels, and each barrel contains three bushels.
