PROPERTY/IMMOVABLE: Provides relative to the transfer of certain state property in St. Mary Parish

AN ACT

2	To authorize and provide for the transfer of certain state property; to authorize the transfer
3	of certain state property in St. Mary Parish; to provide for the property description;
4	to provide for the reservation of mineral rights; to provide terms and conditions; to
5	provide an effective date; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. The secretary of the Department of Transportation and Development and
8	the commissioner of administration, notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary,
9	are hereby authorized and empowered to convey, transfer, assign, lease or deliver any
10	interest, excluding mineral rights, the state may have in and to all or any portion of the
11	following described property to the St. Mary Parish Sheriff's Office:
12 13 14 15 16	One (1) certain tract or parcel of land, and any improvements situated wholly or partially thereon, and specifically including Parcel No. 2714364009.03, and all rights of way, servitudes, privileges and advantages thereunto, situated at 4415 Highway 182, Patterson, in the parish of St. Mary, state of Louisiana, and being more particularly described as follows:

1 Section 2. The secretary of the Department of Transportation and Development and 2 the commissioner of administration are hereby authorized to enter into such agreements, 3 covenants, conditions, and stipulations and to execute such documents as necessary to 4 properly effectuate any conveyance, transfer, assignment, lease or delivery of title, excluding 5 mineral rights, to the property described in Section 1 of this Act, and as more specifically 6 described in any such agreements entered into and documents executed by and between the 7 secretary of the Department of Transportation and Development, the commissioner of 8 administration, and the St. Mary Parish Sheriff's Office, in exchange for consideration 9 proportionate to the appraised value of the property, or as otherwise provided by law. 10 Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 12 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 13 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 14 effective on the day following such approval.
