5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 18:563(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§563. Procedure for voting

9	B. A pre-teen child who is under the age of eighteen may accompany his
10	parent or legal guardian into the voting machine.

Abstract: Increase the maximum age of a child who may accompany a parent or guardian into the voting machine.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 18:563) provides that a child may accompany his parent or legal guardian into the voting machine.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> requires the child to be a pre-teen child.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides instead that the child must be under the age of 18.

(Amends R.S. 18:563(B))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

- The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on House and</u> <u>Governmental Affairs</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:
- 1. Remove provisions of <u>proposed law</u> relative to voter registration.
- 2. Limit the <u>proposed law</u> authorization for a child to accompany a parent or guardian into the voting machine to a child who is under the age of 18.
