BRIDGES/FERRIES: Authorizes free and unhampered passage on the Tomey J. Doucet Bridge for certain emergency vehicles of the town of Grand Isle

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 47:820.5.6, relative to exemptions from tolls on the Tomey J. Doucet Bridge;
3	to provide for the exemptions from tolls for certain vehicles; and to provide for
4	related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 47:820.5.6 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§820.5.6. Free and unhampered passage on the Tomey J. Doucet Bridge; certain
8	emergency vehicles of the town of Grand Isle
9	A.(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the
10	following list of vehicles shall have free and unhampered passage crossing the
11	Tomey J. Doucet Bridge on Louisiana Highway 1 in Leeville, Louisiana:
12	(a) Ambulances of the Grand Isle Emergency Vehicle Services.
13	(b) Official vehicles of the Grand Isle Independent Levee District.
14	(c) Official vehicles and a medical transportation van of the town of Grand
15	Isle.
16	(d) Official, logo-bearing vehicles of the Grand Isle Port Commission.
17	(e) Any person whose permanent residence is located at or south of the
18	juncture of Louisiana Highway 1 and Louisiana Highway 3030 or off of Louisiana
19	Highway 1 east of the juncture of Louisiana Highway 1 and Louisiana Highway
20	<u>3090.</u>

Abstract: Provides relative to free and unhampered passage crossing the Tomey J. Doucet Bridge on La. Hwy. 1, Leeville, La. for certain vehicles of the town of Grand Isle. Adds an exemption from the payment of tolls for certain permanent residents who reside at a specific location.

<u>Proposed law</u> exempts, from the payment of tolls, certain vehicles in the performance of official duties as follows:

- (1) Grand Isle Emergency Vehicle Services (ambulances).
- (2) Grand Isle Independent Levee District.
- (3) Town of Grand Isle official vehicles and a medical transportation van.
- (4) Grand Isle Port Commission official, logo-bearing vehicles.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds any person whose permanent residence is located at or south of the juncture of La. Hwy. 1 and La. Hwy. 3030 or off of La. Hwy. 1 east of the juncture of La. Hwy. 1 and La. Hwy. 3090.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the exemption be granted only when entities under <u>proposed law</u> are being utilized in the performance of their official duties and when certain persons are residing at specific locations under <u>proposed law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires DOTD to promulgate rules and regulations for the efficient implementation and enforcement of the provisions of <u>proposed law</u>.
