AN ACT

To enact R.S. 15:544(D)(3)(e), relative to sex offender registration and notification; to provide with respect to the duration of sex offender registration and notification periods; to amend the definition of "clean record"; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 15:544(D)(3)(e) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§544. Duration of registration and notification period

* * *

(3) For purposes of this Subsection, an offender maintains a "clean record"

by:

* * *

(e) Complying with all sex offender registration and notification requirements pursuant to the provisions of this Chapter.

HB No. 640

Abstract: Requires sex offenders to comply with all sex offender registration and notification requirements in order to be eligible for a reduced registration period.

Present law provides that the period of time a sex offender is required to register can be reduced if the offender maintains a clean record for a certain period of time.

Present law defines "clean record" as all of the following:

- (1) Not being convicted of any offense for which imprisonment for more than one year may be imposed.
- (2) Not being convicted of any sex offense.
- (3) Successfully completing any periods of supervised release, probation, or parole.
- (4) Successfully completing an appropriate sex offender treatment program.

Proposed law retains present law and adds compliance with all sex offender registration and notification requirements to the definition of "clean record".
