| 15 | D. Governance. (1) The district shall be governed by a five-member seven- | |

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the unexpired term in the same manner as the original appointment. If the appointing authority responsible for the appointment of a member fails to fill a vacancy within thirty days, the remaining members of the board shall appoint an interim successor to serve until the position is filled by the appointing authority.

- (b) Board members shall be eligible for reappointment; however, board members shall serve for no more than two consecutive three-year terms. A board member shall be eligible for reappointment to the commission two years from the date of expiration of his second term.
- (5) The board shall elect from its members a chairman, a vice chairman, a secretary-treasurer secretary, a treasurer, and such other officers as it may deem necessary. The offices of secretary and treasurer may be held by the same person. The duties of the officers shall be fixed by the bylaws adopted by the board.
- (6) The minute books and archives of the district shall be maintained by the secretary-treasurer secretary of the board. The monies, funds, and accounts of the district shall be in the official custody of the board.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
