3	for increased penalties when the offender is armed with a dangerous weapon; and to
4	provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 14:62.8(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§62.8. Home invasion
8	* * *
9	B.(1) Except as provided in Paragraph (2) Paragraphs (2) and (3) of this
10	Subsection, whoever commits the crime of home invasion shall be fined not more
11	than five thousand dollars and shall be imprisoned at hard labor for not less than five
12	nor more than twenty years; at least five years of the sentence imposed shall be
13	served without benefit of parole, probation, or suspension of sentence for not more
14	than twenty-five years.
15	(2) Whoever commits the crime of home invasion while armed with a
16	dangerous weapon shall be fined not more than seven thousand dollars and shall be
17	imprisoned at hard labor for not more than thirty years.
18	(2) (3) Whoever commits the crime of home invasion when, at the time of
19	the unauthorized entering, there is present in the dwelling or structure any person
20	who is under the age of twelve years, is sixty-five years of age or older, or who has
21	a developmental disability as defined in R.S. 28:451.2, shall be fined not more than
22	ten thousand dollars and shall be imprisoned at hard labor for not less than ten nor

1	more than twenty-five years. At least ten years of the sentence imposed shall be
2	served without benefit of parole, probation, or suspension of sentence.
