R.S. 45:126 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 6 §126. Utility poles; prohibition 7 A. Notwithstanding any other provision of the law to the contrary, no signs, 8 posters, flyers, or other form of communication shall be erected, displayed, or posted 9 on any public utility pole or stanchion. 10 B. This Section shall not create any additional legal duty on the owners or 11 custodians of such poles or stanchions.

Hazel HB No. 652

Abstract: Prohibits the posting of signs on utility poles or stanchions.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that no signs, posters, flyers, or other form of communication shall be erected, displayed, or posted on any public utility pole or stanchion.

<u>Proposed law</u> does not create any additional legal duty on owners or custodians of such poles or stanchions.
