CULTURE/FRENCH: Provides relative to the membership, powers and duties, and reporting requirements of the Council for the Development of French in Louisiana (CODOFIL)

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 25:652(A)(introductory paragraph) and 655 and to enact R.S.
3	25:652(A)(17) through (22) and 653(F), relative to the Council for the Development
4	of French in Louisiana; to provide for the membership of the council; to provide for
5	the duties, powers, and functions of the council; to provide for the reporting
6	requirements of the council; and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 25:652(A)(introductory paragraph) and 655 are hereby amended and
9	reenacted and R.S. 25:652(A)(17) through (22) and 653(F) are hereby enacted to read as
10	follows:
11	§652. Membership; appointment; terms; vacancies; compensation
12	A. The council shall be composed of twenty-three twenty-nine members as
13	follows:

15	(17) One member appointed by Télé-Louisiane.
16	(18) One member appointed by l'Assemblée de la Louisiane.
17	(19) One member appointed by École Pointe-au-Chien.
18	(20) One member appointed by the Alliance Française of New Orleans.

1	(21) One member appointed by the state-recognized Pointe-au-Chien Indian
2	Tribe.
3	(22) One member appointed by the state-recognized Jean Charles Choctaw

6	§653. Duties, powers, and functions

8	F. The council or its staff shall each year meet with the school boards of each
9	parish identified in R.S. 25:651(C)(5) where no French immersion program exists
10	in order to provide information on the opening of a French immersion program and
11	assist in the process for doing so. The council or its staff shall also meet with charter
12	school organizations, parent groups, or other stakeholders for this purpose.

14	§655. Annual report
15	The council shall submit an annual report to the governor, the lieutenant
16	governor, the president of the Senate, the speaker of the House of Representatives,
17	the chairman of the Senate Committee on Education, and the chairman of the House
18	Committee on Education, not later than March first, regarding all actions taken and
19	progress made toward achieving the purposes and duties set for the council in this
20	Chapter. The report shall be prepared by the staff of the council and shall include
21	specific, numeric metrics of progress toward achieving the purposes provided in R.S.
22	25:651(C), particularly including the number of new French immersion schools per
23	year and the number of new parishes with programs as well as the specific outreach
24	efforts undertaken to expand French immersion to new communities.

**Abstract:** Increases the membership of the Council for the Development of French in La. (CODOFIL) and expands the powers, duties, functions, and reporting responsibilities of the council.

<u>Present law</u> creates CODOFIL within the Dept. of Culture, Recreation and Tourism with the purpose to preserve, promote, and develop Louisiana's French and Creole culture, heritage, and language.

Present law provides for the appointment of 23 members of the council.

Proposed law provides for the addition of six members to the council as follows:

- (1) One member appointed by Télé-Louisiane.
- (2) One member appointed by l'Assemblée de la Louisiane.
- (3) One member appointed by École Pointe-au-Chien.
- (4) One member appointed by the Alliance Française of New Orleans.
- (5) One member appointed by the state-recognized Pointe-au-Chien Indian Tribe.
- (6) One member appointed by the state-recognized Jean Charles Choctaw Nation.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the council or its staff to annually meet with the school boards of each of the parishes specified in <u>present law</u> where no French immersion program exists, charter school organizations, parent groups, or other stakeholders in order to provide information on and assistance with the process of creating such programs.

<u>Present law</u> requires the council to submit an annual report to the governor, the president of the Senate, the speaker of the House, the chairman of the Senate Committee on Education, and the chairman of the House Committee on Education regarding all actions taken and progress made towards achieving the purposes and duties of the council

<u>Proposed law</u> adds the lieutenant governor as a recipient of the council's annual report. Requires the council staff to prepare the report and include specific numeric metrics of progress, including the following:

- (1) The number of new French immersion schools per year
- (2) The number of new parishes with French immersion programs
- (3) The specific outreach efforts undertaken to expand French immersion to new communities.
