Provides for net increases (decreases) as follows: State General Fund Direct (Direct) by \$581,244,917, Interagency Transfers by (\$3,000,000); Fees & Self-generated Revenues by \$8,384,195; Statutory Dedications by \$41,961,795; and Federal Funds by \$6,522,277.
