8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 11:710(A)(5)(e) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

13	(5) "Reemployment-eligible position" means any of the following:

15	(e) A position for a tutor for any student in pre-kindergarten through twelfth
16	grade.

18	Section 2. The cost of this Act, if any, shall be funded with additional employer
19	contributions in compliance with Article X, Section 29(F) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

- 1 Section 3. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2018; if vetoed by the governor
- 2 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
- 3 2018, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.

Abstract: Authorizes a retiree of the Teachers' Retirement System of La. (TRSL) to return to work as a tutor and continue to collect his benefit check, subject to an earnings limitation of 25% of his benefit amount.

<u>Present law</u> generally provides that a retiree of TRSL may not return to work in a position covered by the system and continue to receive retirement benefits while reemployed. Further provides exceptions to <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes a retiree to return to work as a substitute classroom teacher, an adjunct professor, an instructor in an adult literacy program, or a school nurse and to continue to receive his benefit check; however, the allowable employment earnings of such retiree are capped at 25% of his benefit amount. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds tutor for a student in pre-kindergarten through 12th grade to the list of positions that a retiree may return to subject to a 25% earnings limitation.

Effective July 1, 2018.
