2	To amend and reenact R.S. 47:322.5(B) and 332.14, relative to the disposition of certain
3	state sales tax collections in Tangipahoa Parish; to provide for deposits into the
4	Tangipahoa Parish Tourist Commission Fund; to provide for deposits into the
5	Tangipahoa Parish Economic Development Fund; to provide for an effective date;
6	and to provide for related matters.
7	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
8	as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
9	Louisiana.
10	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
11	Section 1. R.S. 47:322.5(B) and 332.14 are hereby amended and reenacted to read
12	as follows:
13	§322.5. Disposition of certain collections in Tangipahoa Parish
14	* * *
15	B. The monies in the Tangipahoa Economic Parish Economic Development
16	Fund shall be subject to an annual appropriation by the legislature. The monies in
17	the fund shall be utilized exclusively for economic development in Tangipahoa
18	Parish. All unexpended and unencumbered monies in the fund at the end of the
19	fiscal year shall remain in the fund. The monies in the fund shall be invested by the
20	treasurer in the same manner as the monies in the state general fund, and all interest
21	earned shall be deposited in the state general fund.
