NURSING HOMES: Exempts municipalities with a certain population level from a moratorium on additional beds for nursing facilities

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 40:2116(D)(3), relative to nursing facilities; to exempt municipalities with a
3 certain population level from a moratorium on additional beds for nursing facilities;
4 and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 40:2116(D)(3) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §2116. Facility need review

11 (3) The moratorium on additional beds for nursing facilities imposed
12 pursuant to Paragraph (2) of this Subsection shall not apply to a nursing facility
13 located in a municipality with a population in excess of three hundred thousand
14 persons as determined by the most recent federal decennial census.

Abstract: Exempts municipalities with a certain population level from a moratorium on additional beds for nursing facilities.

Proposed law exempts a municipality with a population in excess of three hundred thousand persons as determined by the most recent federal decennial census from the moratorium on additional beds for nursing facilities provided in present law.
